**THE NATIONAL INSTITUTES OF HEALTH AWARDS CONTRACT TO
CPS HUMAN RESOURCE SERVICES
*Takes on New and Refresher Supervisors Training Program***

Sacramento, CA - [CPS Human Resource Services \(CPS\)](#) has been awarded a contract from the [National Institutes of Health \(NIH\)](#) to develop and deliver supervisory skills training for new, existing, and potential supervisors in the administrative and scientific fields. NIH, a component of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, is the nation's medical research agency and includes 27 separate institutes and centers. It is the primary federal agency for conducting and supporting basic, clinical and translational medical research and investigating the causes, treatments, and cures for both common and rare diseases. NIH is headquartered in Bethesda, Maryland, and its scientists work throughout the world.

“CPS is prepared and well positioned to partner with the NIH Training Center to help build and provide relevant, usable training,” said Gib Johnson, CPS managing director of the federal consulting practice. “This program will equip NIH managers and supervisors with the knowledge, tools, and understanding required to develop and maintain a highly productive workforce.”

Under the CPS program, NIH supervisors will receive training in subjects such as the art of supervision, performance management and appraisal planning (PMAP), employee and labor relations, and telework. Program measurements include post session evaluations as well as a six-month post program summary overview to determine use and application of learning.
